Dear Sirs:

On February 5, 2007, our Board of Directors approved the following desired future conditions to be presented for consideration by the member districts of GMA 12.

Aquifer	Proposed Desired Future Condition	Comments
Carrizo	Limit the drawdown of the water levels to 150 feet of the current conditions. <i>for 150 feet</i>	
Queen City	Limit the drawdown to 50 feet of the current conditions and limit the drawdown in the outcrop to 5 feet.	
Sparta	Limit the drawdown to 50 feet of the current conditions and limit the drawdown in the outcrop to 5 feet	
Yegua-Jackson	Limit the drawdown to 50 feet of the current conditions and limit the drawdown in the outcrop to 5 feet	This aquifer is not addressed in the Region K Water Plan as of yet. TWDB will have modeling available for this aquifer in 2008.
Colorado Alluvium	Limit the drawdown to 30 feet of the current conditions.	Region K does not address this aquifer in the Water Plan.
