### **Public Hearing to Consider Amending Rules**

The Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District (“POSGCD” or “District”) will hold a public hearing on the amendment of the Rules of the Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District (“Rules”).

The Board of Directors will consider amending the Rules at the Board meeting following the public hearing. The amendments consist of amendments to Section 1 Definitions and Concepts, Section 4 Spacing and Monitoring Requirements, Section 7 Permits, Records, Reports, and Logs, Section 8 Transport of Groundwater, Section 14 Hearings, and Section 16 Management of Water Availability and Production, as well as differentiation of calendar days and business days, and additional clean-up language throughout the Rules. The public hearing and board meeting will be conducted at the District’s office located at 310 East Avenue C in Milano Texas.

All interested persons are invited to attend and provide public comment. Please note: due to the COVID-19 situation, these meetings may be held virtually.
