The number of wells in our Monitoring Network currently is at 407 and is broken down by formation as such:

Field Staff has been collecting water levels from random monitoring wells, with a focus on Carrizo and Simsboro wells since the beginning of July.

A steady effort continues of locating additional monitoring wells and equipping wells for long-term water level measurements near the SLR property (previously Alcoa) to collect base line data prior to pump tests and future long-term production under the SLR Permit.

An upgrade of the telemetry units used to download data from pressure transducers is underway. The new telemetry units will provide better cellular service and connectivity while reducing cost per unit.

Water Level Measurement Campaigns for the remainder of the year will run as follows: (may vary depending on logistics)
